This year's Easter Coaching was very busy, with all day spaces being filled very quickly after our advertising.

We still offered more morning spaces for the 10 – 12am, coaching only sessions.

There were lots of new children the both weeks that had been told about previous coaching courses by friends etc. They were all keen to get started and were all super excited to be trying something new with their friends. They were split into groups based on their ability in their chosen sport i.e., Skateboard, Scooter or Blades, with some of the young people trying different things throughout the week as they had never been to the park before or

had not had the opportunity to try the various activities before.

The children who stayed for the afternoon part of the day spent the first session with the youth workers in the park; this gave the workers the chance to assess how all the young people got along and also if they had and particular special needs.

Over the week the children also went out to Pirate Island, Battlefield Live, Cinema, The Frigate Unicorn, We also had a boys' day, and a girly day this involved the girls nail painting, face painting, make up etc, and the boys had football, basketball etc. The children loved taking part in all these activities and

especially the trip to the Unicorn as it was somewhere that all of the children had never been to before. We also had a Graffiti day which they all enjoy.
