



HOMWORK CLUB SPRING 2015

We continue to run our Homework Club three nights a week (Monday & Wednesday) throughout school term time.

This follows the format of young people arriving at 4.30, spending 45 minutes working on their homework, and then spending 45 minutes on the skatepark. We aim for 30 participations per week across the 3 nights of homework club. In the last 5 weeks before the Easter holidays we averaged 39 participations a week.

We asked the young people attending the homework club to say at the end of each night to answer yes or no to the question 'Did you enjoy homework club tonight?'. Although for various reasons we did not manage to record 193 answers to match the 193 participations in the 5 weeks preceding the Easter Holidays we did record 152 answers. There were 148 yes answers and 4 no answers. This means that those who attended homework club enjoyed it on 97% of visits.

These figures show that we are meeting both the targets that the evaluation is in place to record;

75% of Young People across all programmes report through evaluation that they are

enjoying the programme
There will be 30 participations at homework club per week in school term time.

In the summer term we will be starting a new club for Young People in Primary 7 up to Secondary 3. The idea behind this is that the present three nights we run the club will continue and therefore by adding a new club for the older age group we can support more young people.
