



HOMWORK CLUB SUMMER 2015

This term we changed our Homework Club to accommodate a wider range of ages.

We have continued to run 3 clubs on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday, but have now restricted these sessions to primary school years 1 to 6, and introduced a new homework club for primary 7 to secondary 3 aged young people. This has allowed us to provide a better environment for both age groups.

We aim for 30 participations per week across the 4 sessions. As of July 2015 we are at 729 attendances from 23 weeks, 39 above our target for so far in 2015.

Also, 100% of parents report through evaluation improved educational attainment due to attendance of the Homework Club in 2015, 50% above our target.

We asked the young people attending the homework club to say at the end of each night to answer yes or no to the question "Did you enjoy homework club tonight?". This data was then collated along with the rest of our youth programmes asking the same question so that we found out that 94% of Young People across all programmes report through evaluation that they are enjoying the programme,

which is 19% above our target.

These figures show that we are meeting both the targets that the evaluation is in place to record;

75% of Young People across all programmes report through evaluation that they are enjoying the programme.

There will be 30 participations at homework club per week in school term time.
