



## HOMWORK CLUB AUTUMN TERM 15

In the summer term of 2015 we changed our Homework Club to accommodate a wider range of ages. We continued to run 3 clubs on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday, but restricted these sessions to primary school years 1 to 6, and introduced a new homework club for primary 7 to secondary 3 aged young people.

The idea behind this was to allow us to better accommodate for both age groups and this in turn would mean better attendances. We aim for 30 participations per week across the 4 sessions.

In the Autumn Term we had 252 attendances, 42 above our target for this term.

The Homework Club continues to follow the format of the young people spending 45 minutes on homework followed by 45 minutes of time in the skatepark arena. The club is completely free for everyone to attend and we have materials that fit in with the curriculum followed in the schools for those who do not have homework with them on a particular day.

We also have computers and arts and crafts materials for projects that require extra assistance beyond young people being given a pen or pencil.

With educational attainment at a low level in the DD4 8 area there is a continued need for the homework club to help young people from the age of 5 right through their school years.
