Our Homework Club runs Monday to Wednesday during term time. We cater for both primary and secondary school young people on a weekly basis.

Completion of homework is rewarded with time in the skatepark arena with assistance and supervision from staff and volunteers both in doing homework and on the skatepark.

Attendance levels have been very good once again. As a stable and long-running club it is encouraging to see young people regularly attending and progressing in their learning out with school.

The number of people coming along shows there is a need for assistance for young people with homework, especially those in the local area.

Through evaluation those at primary school are reporting almost across the board every week that they are enjoying the club. Those who are older and at secondary school are asked more questions focused around development of social skills, self-worth, and attitudes towards learning. This term the feedback shows that this club is having a positive effect on these young people in that they are interacting with each other in a more positive manner,

taking the initiative and responsibility when it comes to their learning, and feeling more capable of achieving in terms of homework, school work, and in the skatepark.
