



HOMWORK CLUBS - SUMMER 2016

Homework Club runs Monday to Wednesday during Dundee School term time. With specific clubs for young people of both primary and secondary school age there is a chance for everyone who wishes to have assistance with their homework to do so.

Young people who complete their homework are rewarded with time in the skatepark arena. Staff and volunteers are on hand to assist both with their school work and in the skatepark arena with whatever tricks and flicks young people want to learn.

Homework Club has run at The Factory Skatepark for many years now and is a staple part of the overall youth programme. There will always be homework handed out by schools to young people and there will always be a need for assistance to be available for young people.

In evaluation we ask young people whether they are enjoying the club and getting the level of support they need. Especially with those at secondary school we ask them if they are becoming more confident in their learning academically, and feeling more able to ask the questions they need answered in school. I am pleased to report that feedback across the

board is positive, with young people reporting that they are more confident in school and at this club and subsequently have developed their self-worth, have developed their social skills, and have an improved attitude to learning. As you would expect attendances are high, achieving the targets set on a weekly basis.

Homework Club will return after the summer holidays as usual.
