

Summer Holiday Programme

2010 Report

The Factory Skatepark ran a 4 week holiday programme consisting of sport coaching in the morning between 10am to 12pm, and after lunch afternoon activities which ran until 3pm. These activities were overseen by the Factory's youth work team and consisted of trips out, multi sport activities, games and computer games on the newly acquired Wii and PS3.

32 places over the holidays were subsidised by the local Dundee Partnership fund and this allowed 8 young people per week the opportunity to access the programme. In total over the 4 weeks 59 young people attended the programme with 52 of the young people staying on for the whole day's provision.

The successes of the coaching programme could be measured by the skills the young people developed through the coaching sessions as this really boosted confidence and self esteem. This was reflected in the fact that the young people were always eager to show off the new skills they had developed.
